Thank you for your request for information, received yesterday 3rd April 2018, which we have dealt with under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

JNCC would reply under EIR Reg. 12(4)(a) *Does not hold that information*. Details relating to ownership of land designated as a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) are held by the statutory nature conservation agencies for the country in question, in this instance Scotland. Therefore, you would need to contact Scotlish Natural Heritage (SNH).
