



- Bare ground: Low productivity, High mean Red, Low standard deviation of Red
- Canopy gaps: bare ground, within 'Woodland'
- Disturbance: Occurrence and frequency of bare ground
- Elevation: From DSM
- Productivity: NDVI (Red and NIR bands) and/or PV/NPV endmembers
- Slope: Derived from DSM
- Sward density: Productivity, mean Red, standard deviation of Red
- Wetness: Low SWIR, Low NIR
- Woodiness: Green and SWIR
