Request

Hi, I would like to make an FoI request for any information relating to communications between JNCC and Defra about what will replace Article 10, if anything, when EU Regulation 338/97 is no longer relevant after Brexit.

Reply

Thank you for your request for information, received by JNCC on Monday 2 July 2018, which we have dealt with under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

You requested any information relating to communications between JNCC and Defra about what will replace Article 10, if anything, when EU Regulation 338/97 is no longer relevant after Brexit.

After careful consideration, and consultation with Defra, our view is that your request 'relates to material which is still in the course of completion, to unfinished documents or to incomplete data' under regulation 12(4)(d) and disclosure of the information would also adversely affect the confidentiality of proceedings of both Defra and the JNCC in accordance with regulation 12(5)(d).

Both JNCC and Defra consider that the information requested is confidential at this time as it relates to the ongoing development of EU Exit policy. Release of correspondence between JNCC and Defra, at this time, would prove detrimental to the development of any necessary policy. The public interest is therefore in favour of non-disclosure.

With regard to what may replace Article 10 when the UK has left the EU, we would note that the UK is a party to CITES in its own right and will continue to be bound by the Convention after EU Exit. The UK will use the powers under the Withdrawal Act to bring the current EU Wildlife Trade Regulations (338/97 and related Regulations) into UK law.
