#### **Executive Summary**

##### **1. Action required**

1.1. The Joint Committee is asked to:

- i. **identify** any changes in the external environment that are relevant to the implementation of JNCC’s strategy and business plan;
- ii. **provide updates** on any significant changes within the country nature conservation bodies or government administrations.

##### **2. Key issues**

2.1. JNCC’s new strategy sets the direction for JNCC for the next five years. JNCC’s business plan for 2021/22 contains the work programme for the current year.
