On the positive side, there had been an encouraging buzz in the room; informative presentations that had been well delivered; good attendance and positive connections made with colleagues in Natural Resources Wales (NRW) and Welsh Government. On the negative side, the acoustics in the room could have been better and given the topic, there could have been more decision makers amongst the audience.
- 4.2 In discussion on the event, Committee made the following comments:
  - i. 40 minutes for the breakout session had not been sufficient time to explore the questions in detail.

- ii. It was unclear how the outputs from the event would be used going forward.
- iii. A larger scale event might have worked better for the topic and drawn in a wider audience.
- 4.3 In conclusion, Committee agreed that such events are good networking opportunities, but different fora might work better to explore these kinds of issues in more detail e.g. roundtables with ministers or invited industry representatives. There was a need to rethink how these events should be undertaken, disentangling networking from more in-depth discussions on particular topics and to consider where such events are held to maximise their reach and impact and to target key stakeholders on the ground. Members agreed that actions and outputs from this event should be captured and disseminated.
